

Permanent Mission of the Republic of Yemen to the United Nations**New York****Information presented by the Republic of Yemen regarding paragraph 15 of General Assembly resolution 63/119 on criminal accountability of United Nations officials and experts on mission**

Article 3 of the Yemeni Penal Code adopts the principle of territoriality. Therefore, all Yemeni nationals serving as United Nations officials or experts are subject to all relevant legal provisions should they commit any act that constitutes a crime under the Penal Code. With respect to the immunity granted to the aforementioned nationals, such immunity is restricted to oral or written statements they make in their official capacities and that are related to their work.
