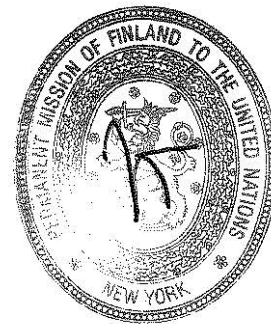

The Permanent Mission of Finland to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the note LA/COD/50 of 14 January 2014, has the honour to transmit the following information pursuant to the United Nations General Assembly resolution 68/105 of 16 December 2013, entitled "Criminal accountability of United Nations officials and experts on mission".

No crimes of a serious nature committed by Finnish nationals while serving as United Nations officials or experts on mission have been brought to the attention of the Finnish authorities. Nor are the Finnish authorities aware of any allegations, investigations or proceedings against Finnish nationals suspected of having committed such crimes while serving as United Nations officials and experts on mission. Should such allegations be made, all appropriate measures would be taken to investigate and prosecute those crimes in accordance with the Finnish law.

The Permanent Mission of Finland to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurance of its highest consideration.
