Criminal accountability of United Nations officials and experts on mission

Follow-up to General Assembly resolution 75/132 of 15 December 2020

Input from Belgium

In response to the note verbale from the Secretary-General dated 18 December 2020 concerning the criminal accountability of United Nations officials and experts on mission, Belgium has the honour to convey the following information:

In 2020, Belgium was informed by the Secretary-General of an allegation of a serious offence brought against a Belgian national serving as a United Nations official or expert on mission. The information was transmitted directly to the competent judicial authorities.

In accordance with the annual resolution of the General Assembly on the criminal accountability of United Nations officials and experts on mission, Belgium has informed the Secretary-General of the measures taken in that case and has responded to any request for information from his office.
