VERBAL NOTE

The Permanent Mission of Greece to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Office of Legal Affairs of the United Nations and, with reference to the Latter's Note LA/COD/50/1, dated 11 January 2022 and General Assembly's Resolution 76/106 of 9 December 2021, has the honor to refer, with respect to Greece's criminal legislation, to the information and excerpts of relevant national provisions provided by the Permanent Mission of Greece in Verbal Note ref. No. 90.2.5.6/AS 976, dated 22 May 2020. The only amendment, by Law No. 4855/2021 published in the Official Gazette No. 215 (Vol. A) of 12 November 2021, regarding the aforementioned legislation has been the replacement of the term "perjury" with the term "false testimony" in Article 8 (e) of the Greek Penal Code.

The Permanent Mission of Greece to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to reiterate to the Office of Legal Affairs of the United Nations the assurances of its highest consideration.
