UN INTERNAL JUSTICE SYSTEM: TIMELINES

The following table explains timelines applicable to staff members of the Secretariat and funds, programmes and entities.

SUBMISSION TIME LIMIT***

Request for management evaluation*

60 DAYS

after the staff member was notified of the contested administrative decision

Administration to provide management evaluation

30 DAYS

New York Headquarters staff (Geneva Headquarters staff for the Office of the High Commissioner for Refugees)

45 DAYS

non-Headquarters staff

Application to Dispute Tribunal

90 DAYS

from receipt of management evaluation, or 90 days from date evaluation should have been received (namely, 30 DAYS for disputes arising at Headquarters and 45 DAYS for disputes arising at other offices)

90 DAYS

from receipt of administrative decision in cases where a management evaluation is not required

90 DAYS

from the day the mediation broke down in cases where mediation through the Mediation Division of Office of the Ombudsman and Mediation Services was undertaken

Appeal to **Appeals** Tribunal**

60 DAYS

from receipt of judgment of the Dispute Tribunal

30 DAYS

from receipt of an interlocutory order of the Dispute Tribunal

from notification of the appeal

In those cases, an application can be made to the Dispute Tribunal.
