1. On 10 July 2019, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Nairobi (UNDT) issued Judgment No. UNDT/2019/126 in the case of *Ross v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.
2. Both Mr. Felix Ross and the Secretary-General have appealed the UNDT Judgment to the United Nations Appeals Tribunal. Their appeals have been registered separately as Case No. 2019-1313 and Case No. 2019-1314.
3. Under Article 18*bis* of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure, “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”.
4. In light of the fact that the two appeals before us challenge the same UNDT Judgment, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate them for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2019-1313 and 2019-1314 should be consolidated for all purposes.
