ORDER No. 543 (2023)

1. On 11 May 2023, the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (UNAT or Appeals Tribunal) issued Judgment No. 2023-UNAT-1343 in the matter of *Ann-Christin Raschdorf v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*, whereby the UNAT dismissed Ms. Ann-Christin Raschdorf's appeal and affirmed Judgment No. UNDT/2022/004 (UNAT Judgment).
2. On 21 May 2023, Ms. Raschdorf filed an application for revision of the UNAT Judgment, and the Secretary-General filed his comments on 22 June 2023. This case was registered as Case No. 2023-1803.
3. On 23 May 2023, Ms. Raschdorf filed an application for correction of the UNAT Judgment, and the Secretary-General filed his comments on 22 June 2023. This case was registered as Case No. 2023-1806.
4. On 30 May 2023, Ms. Raschdorf filed an application for interpretation of the UNAT Judgment, and the Secretary-General filed his comments on 21 June 2023. This case was registered as Case No. 2023-1809.
5. Under Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure, "[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties".

6. Because the three applications before us challenge the same UNAT Judgment, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case[s] and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate them for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2023-1803, 2023-1806 and 2023-1809 should be consolidated for all purposes.
