Introduction

1. The Applicant is a P-5 level, Chief of Section at the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa (ECA) based in Addis-Ababa, Ethiopia.
2. He filed an incomplete application with the Dispute Tribunal on 20 May 2019.
3. On 21 May 2019, the Registry informed the Applicant that he was required to file complete pleadings articulating why he considered the contested administrative decision to be unlawful. He was also informed that the incomplete application would not be served on the Respondent.
4. On 22 May 2019, the Applicant informed the Tribunal that the matter was being informally resolved.
5. On 28 May 2019, the Applicant filed a submission stating that he seeks to withdraw the application “given the successful outcome of negotiation between [him] and the administration”.

Conclusion

6. As the Applicant has withdrawn his application, there being no matter for adjudication by the Dispute Tribunal, Case No. UNDT/NBI/2019/049 is hereby closed.
