Introduction

1. By application filed on 7 September 2015, the Applicant contests a decision of 7 May 2015 by the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo to refuse to exercise its discretion to award her a dependency allowance in respect of her son, Michael Pollock.
2. The application was served on the Respondent on 9 September 2015, who was granted until 9 October 2015 to file a reply.

Consideration

3. In view of the Applicant's submissions, and pursuant to art. 19 (Case management) of its Rules of Procedure, the Tribunal deems it appropriate to convoke the parties to a case management discussion. Given that the matter raised in the application shall be addressed in priority, the Tribunal finds that it is in the interest of justice to hold this discussion without undue delay, before the filing of the Respondent's reply.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The parties attend a case management discussion on **Wednesday, 30 September 2015, at 2 p.m.** (Geneva time).
5. The Registry inform the parties in due course of the logistical details in relation to the hearing.
