Introduction

. The Applicant served on a fixed-term appointment at the P-5 level in the

United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of

Women ("UN Women").

2. On 11 March 2019, he was placed on administrative leave with full pay

pending the outcome of an investigation into allegations of abuse of authority and

harassment. The Applicant submitted his resignation the next day and on

13 March 2019 sought management evaluation of the decision to place him on

administrative leave.

3. On 6 June 2019, he filed an application before the Geneva Registry of the

United Nations Dispute Tribunal to challenge the decision to place him on

administrative leave with full pay.

4. The Respondent filed his reply on 11 July 2018. It is the Respondent's case

that the impugned decision was lawful, and that the application should be dismissed

in its entirety.

Considerations and Order

5. The Tribunal has reviewed the parties' submissions to date and considers that

a case management discussion ("CMD") would facilitate fair, efficient and

expeditious management and disposal of this case. Given the nature of the matter

at hand, the Tribunal decides to hold the CMD in camera. The Tribunal reserves its

decision concerning the modalities for a hearing on the merits, if any.

6. The CMD will take place on Friday, 19 February 2021 at

12 p.m. (Geneva time) using Microsoft Teams. At the CMD, the Tribunal and the

parties will:

a. Ascertain whether the parties are amenable to considering an alternative

resolution to the dispute;

b. Identify the factual and legal issues to be determined;

c. Consider what further information, if any, is required;

d. Identify any documents to be disclosed;

e. Consider if the case may be decided on the basis of the documents, or whether a hearing should be held, and, if there is to be a hearing, to set the

dates, identify the witnesses to be called and the documents to be

presented; and

f. Discuss any other matter relevant to these proceedings.

7. As the CMD is being held virtually with all parties appearing from their

respective locations, the parties are requested to confirm to the Geneva Registry

their contact details by Wednesday, 10 February 2021 (COB Geneva time).
