## **Introduction**

1. On 4 November 2024, the Applicant, a Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Officer with the United Nations Office of Drugs and Crime (“UNODC”) in Vienna, filed an application contesting his step placement upon promotion.
2. On 5 December 2024, the Respondent filed his reply.

## **Consideration**

### *Filing of a rejoinder*

3. Having perused the case file, the Tribunal considers it appropriate and in the interest of justice to direct the Applicant to file a rejoinder.

### *Amicable settlement*

4. Recalling that the General Assembly has consistently encouraged alternative dispute resolution, the Tribunal finds it also appropriate to encourage the parties to explore the possibility of having the dispute between them resolved without recourse to further litigation.

## **Conclusion**

5. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:
  - a. By **Friday, 14 February 2025**, the Applicant shall file his rejoinder; and
  - b. The parties shall explore resolving the dispute amicably and revert to the Tribunal in this respect by **Friday, 28 February 2025**.
