Background

1. On 11 December 2019, the Tribunal issued Order No. 214 (NBI/2019) directing the Parties to file final submissions by 31 December 2019 which they did.
2. On 16 December 2019, the Applicant filed a Motion seeking the Tribunal's permission to introduce several documents and communications from the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund (UNJSPF) and medical reports relevant to her claim for compensation and moral damages into evidence. These documents are:
 - a. communications from UNJSPF Client Services regarding reduced benefit entitlement;
 - b. 2019 medical report from Nairobi Hospital; and
 - c. 2016 medical reports from MONUSCO and bill for hospitalization.
