# **ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT**

## Introduction

1. By Order No. 040 (NBI/2020), the parties were informed that the Tribunal had been forced to reschedule the hearing of the case from 26 - 27 February 2020 and invited them to select either 11-12 March 2020 or 1-2 April 2020 as new hearing dates.

2. By the same Order, at paragraph 5, the Respondent was directed to indicate whether the circumstances for which the Applicant proposed witnesses are disputed and, if so, which ones and to what extent. Based on the Respondent's response, the Tribunal will decide on the necessity of calling the Applicant's witnesses.

3. By the same Order, at paragraph 6, the Applicant was directed to list documents she considers to be relevant to the case. The Applicant was also directed to either file specific documents with an explanation of their relevance or, to the extent that she appears to be seeking disclosure of documents in the Respondent's possession, she must identify precisely which documents she wants to be disclosed and their relevance to the subject of the application. Absent an appropriate filing by 24 February 2020, no documents would be sought.

4. On 24 February 2020, the Respondent complied with the Order and filed his submissions, where, among others, he sought leave to add Mr. Aggrey Kedogo to his list of witnesses. On the same day, 24 February 2020, the Applicant filed two documents, the relevance of which is neither apparent nor explained. She also requested an extension of time for effecting her filing.

### ORDERS

5. The Respondent's request to add Mr. Aggrey Kedogo among his witnesses is granted.

6. Given that the Applicant failed to submit the documents within the deadline and in the format required at paragraph 6 of Order No. 040 (NBI/2020), no further documents are allowed from her at this stage.
