# ORDER ON THE PARTIES' JOINT MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEEDINGS

Introduction

1. On 20 February 2025, the Applicant, a former FS-4 Close Protection Officer

at the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali

filed an application contesting his separation from service.

2. The Respondent's reply is due on 24 March 2025.

3. On 4 March 2025, the parties filed a joint motion requesting the Tribunal to

suspend the proceedings until 3 April 2025 and extend the deadline for filing the

Respondent's reply to 2 May 2025 on the ground that they are making good faith

efforts to resolve the matter informally.

Consideration

4. The Tribunal commends the parties for attempting to resolve this case and

encourages their discussions to continue.

5. However, their settlement efforts should not impact these proceedings, and

certainly not to the extent of granting a six-week extension of the time to file a

reply. If anything, the reply should help in settlement discussions as the

Respondent's position will be on the record, known to all parties, and taken into

account in analysing their likelihood of success if the case does not settle.

Conclusion

6. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

a. The motion to suspend proceedings is DENIED; present proceedings

before the Tribunal are suspended during the parties' settlement discussions

until Thursday, 3 April 2025;

b. The Respondent shall file his reply on 24 March 2025 in accordance

with art. 10 of the Rules of Procedure; and

c. If a settlement agreement is reached, the parties shall inform the Tribunal accordingly without delay, and the Applicant shall confirm to the Tribunal, in writing, that his application is withdrawn.
