ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. The Applicant is an Assistant Public Health Officer (NOA, step 9) at the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (“UNHCR”) in Lebanon, Beirut.

2. On 27 March 2025, she filed an incomplete application for suspension of action (annexes 16 and 17 are missing) to stay the Respondent’s decision to select another candidate for the position of Associate Public Health Officer (NOB) following a recruitment process. In her application, the Applicant submits that the selected candidate has not yet assumed the position, making it crucial to suspend the implementation of the selection decision immediately to prevent irreversible consequences.

Conclusion

3. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

- a. The Registry is directed to serve the application for suspension of action on the Respondent;
- b. The Respondent is directed to file his reply to the application for suspension of action within three days of the complete application being served; and
- c. If, indeed, the offer has not been sent to the selected candidate, the Respondent shall hold the offer pending review of the present application and refrain from taking any action concerning the contested decision.
