Introduction

1. The Applicant held a fixed term appointment while she served at the United

Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) Country Office in Zambia.

2. On 19 March 2025, she filed an application with the United Nations Dispute

Tribunal sitting in Nairobi to challenge the terms of her separation from service

following the abolishment of the post she encumbered. It is the Applicant's case

that she was entitled to both notice of separation and the payment of termination

indemnity.

3. The Respondent replied to the application on 9 April 2025. The Respondent

submits that this application is not materially receivable, in that the Applicant has

not identified a reviewable administrative decision to challenge. She seeks to

challenge the restructuring which abolished her post, rather than the decision not to

renew her appointment when it expired.

Consideration

4. The Tribunal has considered the parties' submissions and deems it

appropriate to give the Applicant the opportunity to respond to the Respondent's

reply, particularly on the issue of receivability.

Conclusion

5. The Applicant is directed to file her rejoinder by **30 June 2025.**
