## **Introduction**

1. The Applicant serves as a Chinese Reviser within the Department for General Assembly and Conference Management (DGACM) at the United Nations Office at Nairobi (UNON). He holds a continuing appointment at the P-4 level.
2. On 25 March 2025, he filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal sitting in Nairobi challenging the selection exercise for Job Opening 229157 (three posts), following which he was rostered but not selected.
3. The Respondent replied to the application on 24 April 2025. The Respondent submits that this application should be dismissed on the merits. The Applicant was given full and fair consideration in the selection process and has not shown that the impugned decision was tainted by any extraneous factors that render it unlawful.
