## **Introduction**

1. By application filed on 13 June 2025, the Applicant contests the United Nations Support Mission in Libya's 17 November 2024 decision to recover from her the reductions made to her rent payments for her assigned accommodation for the period from 21 February 2021 to 19 April 2023.
2. By the same application, the Applicant submitted a motion to exceed the 10-page limit.
3. On 18 July 2025, the Respondent filed his reply.

## **Consideration**

### *Motion to exceed page limit*

4. The Tribunal notes that the Applicant requests to exceed the page limit by only two pages, from 10 to 12 pages. The Tribunal further observes that in his reply, the Respondent did not oppose the Applicant's motion to exceed the page limit.
5. Considering the unique circumstances of this case, the Tribunal finds it appropriate to grant the motion.

### *Amicable settlement*

6. Recalling that the General Assembly has consistently encouraged alternative dispute resolution, the Tribunal finds it also appropriate to encourage the parties to explore the possibility of having the dispute between them resolved without recourse to further litigation. This is particularly appropriate in this case which involves a relatively small amount of money.

## **Conclusion**

7. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:
  - a. The Tribunal grants the Applicant's motion and allows a 12-page application; and

b. The parties shall explore resolving the dispute amicably and revert to the Tribunal in this respect by **Wednesday, 13 August 2025**.
