Introduction

1. On 24 July 2025, the Applicant filed an application contesting the decision to delay the issuance of his pension forms for a prolonged period until the conclusion of an Office of Internal Oversight Services' investigation against him for a possible

fraud ("the contested decision").

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 27 August 2025 arguing that the application

is not receivable because the contested decision is not appealable and that the

Applicant failed to request management evaluation of the decision that is capable

of being reviewed.

Consideration

3. This is one of several similar cases pending before the Tribunal arising from the Organization taking similar contested decisions in respect of separating staff

members of the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the

Democratic Republic of the Congo ("MONUSCO"). Counsel representing the

parties in these cases are either the same person(s) or from the same offices, that is,

the Office of Staff Legal Assistance for the Applicants, or from the Division of

Administrative Law, Administrative Law Division, Office of Human Resources,

for Respondent.

4. In view of the foregoing, the Tribunal, in accordance with art. 19 of the UNDT

Rules of Procedure, considers it appropriate to issue the following orders for the

fair and expeditious disposal of the case.

IT IS ORDERED THAT

5. The Respondent's motion seeking leave to exceed the page limit is granted

and the reply is accepted.

6. By or before 5 p.m. (Nairobi time) on Friday, 5 September 2025, the

Applicant shall file a rejoinder specifically addressing the issue of receivability

raised by the Respondent.

7. The parties shall file closing submissions by 5 p.m. (Nairobi time) on Thursday, 11 September 2025.
