Introduction

1. On 19 August 2025, the Tribunal rendered judgment UNDT/2025/054 in the

matter of Kebede v Secretary General of the United Nations.

2. As part of that judgment, the Tribunal stated as follows:

Given the findings regarding the misconduct of Mr. Alhagi Marong

in this case, the obvious issue is whether he should be permitted to appear as a legal representative before the Dispute Tribunal in the future. Before making a final determination on this issue, the

Tribunal will accord Mr. Marong due process by allowing him to file a submission setting forth any reasons why he should not be

disbarred from future appearances before the UN Dispute Tribunal.

3. On 28 August 2025, Counsel filed the subject motion of the present Order

seeking interpretation of that paragraph in the judgment. Specifically, counsel is

seeking clarification on "whether the "show cause" submission should be filed on

an ex parte basis, given that it relates only to Counsel for the Respondent and his

standing before the UNDT."

Consideration

4. The Tribunal agrees with counsel that the "show cause" submission expected

from him relates only to him and his standing before the Tribunal. To that end, the

Tribunal accepts that that submission can properly be filed ex parte.

5. In the interest of transparency of proceedings before the Dispute Tribunal,

however, the ultimate order will be public (and may include reference or quotes

from the *ex parte* filing).

Conclusion

6. The Tribunal DIRECTS counsel to file his submission *ex parte*.
