Introduction

On 24 July 2025, the Applicant, a staff member working with the Office for

the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs, filed an application contesting a decision

awarding her partial reimbursement of her claim for compensation for the loss of

personal effects.

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 2 September 2025, in which it is argued that

the contested decision is not receivable ratione temporis.

3. The Respondent further contends that the contested decision was lawful.

Consideration

4. Having examined the evidence on record to date, the Tribunal finds that the

case is briefed enough, and that the matter can be determined without holding a

hearing or submission of additional evidence. However, the parties may file closing

submissions if they so desire.

Conclusion

5. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

> a. On or before **Monday**, **27 October 2025**, the parties may file closing

submissions if they choose.

b. The submissions shall not exceed **five pages**, using Times New Roman,

font size 12 pts and 1.5 line spacing.
