## **Introduction**

1. On 16 October 2025, the Respondent filed a reply to the Applicant's suspension of action application.
2. On 17 October 2025, the Respondent filed a motion stating that while filing the reply, three annexes were inadvertently uploaded as "standard" documents rather than on an "*ex-parte*" basis.
3. The Respondent submits that these documents contain confidential information and the names of third parties not connected to these proceedings. The Respondent requests the Tribunal:
  - a. To reclassify as "*ex parte*" the three annexes listed above which were inadvertently uploaded as "standard"; and,
  - b. To instruct the Applicant that, should any of these unredacted documents have been downloaded, they are to be deleted and not shared or otherwise disseminated.

## **IT IS ORDERED THAT**

4. The Respondent's motion is granted.
5. The Registry shall reclassify the said documents as *ex parte* in the Court Case Management System; and

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6. The Applicant shall delete any of the documents if they have been downloaded and shall not disclose the contents to any other party.
