Introduction

1. By application filed on 1 September 2025, the Applicant contests United

Nations Population Fund's ("UNFPA") decision to withhold his separation

payments and the associated request for him to reimburse the Organisation.

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 3 October 2025, arguing that the decision

was lawfully taken and meets the criteria set out in staff rule 10.1(b) and the

Tribunal's jurisprudence in *Elobaid* UNDT/2025/032.

3. On 29 October 2025, the parties filed a motion for suspension of proceedings.

The motion says that they have engaged in settlement discussions, that these "initial

exchanges have been constructive, and both parties have expressed a willingness to

pursue settlement discussions". The parties indicated that "a short suspension of the

current proceedings would facilitate their discussions and potentially lead to a

mutually agreeable outcome."

Consideration

4. The Tribunal deems it appropriate to suspend the proceedings in this matter

for one month, to allow the parties time to continue engaging in settlement

discussions.

Conclusion

5. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:

a. The proceedings before the Tribunal shall be suspended until **Friday**,

28 November 2025 for the purpose of allowing the parties to engage in

settlement discussions;

b. If a settlement agreement is reached within this period, the parties shall

inform the Tribunal accordingly without delay, and the Applicant shall

confirm to the Tribunal, in writing, that his application is withdrawn; or

c. If no settlement can be reached within the prescribed period, the parties shall inform the Tribunal, which will resume the proceedings in the matter.
