Introduction

1. On Sunday, 7 April 2019, the Applicant filed an application wherein he describes the contested decision at the relevant paragraph “V. Details of the Contested Decision” as the “decision not to set the record straight and clear [his] name and refusal to provide a safe working environment”.

2. On 13 May 2019, the Respondent filed his reply submitting that the application is not receivable on several grounds, including that the Applicant fails to identify any reviewable administrative decision in his application.

Consideration

3. Having reviewed the parties’ submissions, the Tribunal considers it appropriate and in the interests of justice to direct the Applicant to file further submissions on the matter of receivability.

4. Pursuant to art. 19 of the Dispute Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and for a fair disposal of the case,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

5. By **4:00 p.m., on Friday, 16 October 2020**, the Applicant is to file a response to each of the Respondent’s contentions on receivability raised in the reply. The submission is to be five pages maximum, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing.
