The closing statements are solely to be based on previously filed pleadings and evidence, and no new pleadings or evidence are allowed at this stage.

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5. Unless otherwise ordered, on receipt of the closing statements or at the expiration of the provided time limit, the Tribunal will adjudicate the matter and deliver Judgment based on the case record.
