

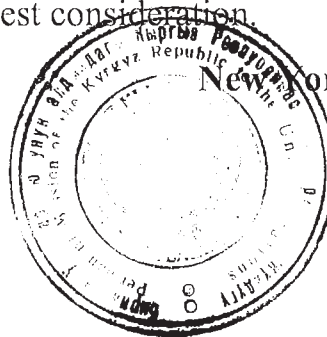

Decision No. 443 of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic, dated 24 July 2017, approving the 2017–2019 Action Plan of the Kyrgyz Republic on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004)

To ensure the effective implementation of the provisions of Security Council resolutions 1540 (2004) and 1977 (2011), in accordance with articles 10 and 17 of the Constitutional Act of the Kyrgyz Republic on the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic, the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic decides that:

1. The 2017–2019 Action Plan of the Kyrgyz Republic on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004), set out in the annex hereto, is hereby approved.

2. Ministries, State committees, administrative departments and other State bodies shall:

- Take comprehensive action to implement the Action Plan within the allotted time frame;

- Submit, for compilation, information on the implementation of the Action Plan to the Ministry of Economic Affairs at the mid-year and end-of-year points, no later than the fifteenth day of the month following the reporting period.

3. The Ministry of Economic Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic shall submit a summary of the status of implementation of the Action Plan to the Office of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic no later than the twenty-fifth day of the month following the reporting period.

4. Heads of executive State bodies of the Kyrgyz Republic shall be held personally accountable for the proper and timely implementation of the Action Plan.

5. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic shall notify the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1540 (2004) of the approval of the Action Plan.

6. Decision No. 144 of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic, dated 22 March 2013, approving the Action Plan of the Kyrgyz Republic on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004), is hereby repealed.

7. The department of defence, law and order and emergency situations of the Office of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic shall be responsible for the implementation of this Decision.

8. The present Decision shall enter into force on the day of its official publication.
