National report on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004) on weapons of mass destruction

Page 11: “OP 3 (a) and (b) — Account for/Secure/Physically protect CW including Related Materials”

In the “National legal framework” column, with respect to points 1 and 2 concerning “Measures to account for production” and “Measures to account for use”, respectively, add “**annual declaration**”.

Page 13: “OP 3 (a) and (b) — Account for/Secure/Physically protect NW including Related Materials”

Note the following changes:

- The date of issuance of the decree implementing Law No. 005-71 is **28 October 1997**, not 28 October 1977. This change should also be made in the rest of the document (p. 13, points 7, 8, 9, 12 and 15; p. 23, points 11 and 25).
 - With respect to point 10, “Other measures for securing”, it should be noted that the National Radiological Protection Centre and port authorities are putting procedures in place to combat illicit trafficking in radioactive materials.
 - In this connection, the indication “**procedure relating to the radiological monitoring of goods at borders**” should be added in the “National legal framework” column.
