Training workshop on UN Security Council resolution 1540 (2004), 18-19 November 2014, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.



This workshop was organized in collaboration with the AU Commission, and aimed to impart practical information, skills and guidance on Member States obligations under the operative paragraphs of the resolution. It focused on the role and responsibilities of National Points of

Contact, as well as on best practices on how to elaborate voluntary National Action Plans (NAP), develop and implement legislative and other control measures, and prepare national reports on implementation.

UNREC emphasized its commitment to effective cooperation and partnerships with Member States, international organizations, civil society organizations, industry, scientific and other professional communities in Africa, to support the objectives of resolution 1540. The workshop was funded by the African Union.
