Contents	<p>Romania take concrete actions in order to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Support the European Union willingness to commit to reduce of 30% of green house emissions by 2020 compared with 1990 as its contribution to a global and comprehensive agreement for the period beyond 2012; - Sustain the EU commitment to a binding target of a 20% share of renewable energies in the overall EU energy consumption by 2020 and to improve by 2020 its energy efficiency by 20%; - Put into practice its National Strategy on Energy Efficiency, Strategy for Renewable Energy Source Capitalization; National Strategy on Climate Changes and National Action Plan on Climate Changes; - Support the investments which envisage the growing energy efficiency, including through Kyoto flexible mechanism utilization and through the implementation of the EU-ETS. Such kind of investments has positive effects not only on environment but also on economy.
Expected results	As results of the taken actions is expected to increase energy efficiency, promote of renewable energy use, decrease energy intensity and reduce the green house gas emissions.
