

Promotion of Renewable energy sources in Slovenia

Leading Actor(s)	Government of the Republic of Slovenia
Participating actor(s)	Ministry of the environment Ministry of the economy
Main objective(s)	Increase the share of renewable sources in the primary energy supply from 8.8 % in 2002 to 12 % by 2010, increase the share of renewables in the supply of heat from 22 % in 2002 to 25 % by 2010, increase the share of electricity from renewables from 32 % in 2002 to 33.6 % by 2010, reach the 5 % share of biofuels for transport by the end of 2010. Specific targets for single renewable sources (wind, solar,...) are not set.
Contents	Targets are set in a Resolution on National energy program. Supporting mechanisms for the heat and power sectors: Energy Act, for biofuels: Excise Duty Act.
Expected results	Currently on the good track to reach the heat target, but not the electricity and biofuels targets
Target area / place	Slovenia
Arrangement(s) for financing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The purchase price of electricity energy from the power plants on renewables (feed-in tariff), • Biofuels for road transport are excused from the excise tax, • Co financing of investment projects for the use of wood biomass for the production of heat with investment subsidies and with the loan with subsidized interest rate.
