Excellencies,

I have the honour to refer to your Note dated 21 January 2015 transmitting the elements paper for drafting of the outcome document of the Third International Conference on Financing for Development to be held during 13-16 July 2015 in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, which served as the basis for discussion during the recent first drafting session held during 27-29 January 2015 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York.

In this connection, I have further the honour to transmit herewith inputs from the Government of Thailand to be included in the elements as follows:

**1. Part II Building Blocks (b) Domestic and international private finance:** *Enhance small and medium enterprises' (SMEs) capacity through assistance in developing SMEs database, access to finance and credit scoring, especially in developing countries and least developed countries (LDCs).*

**2. Part II Building Blocks (c) International public finance:** *Enhance triangular cooperation particularly with national or regional economic development institutions which are equipped with knowledge, expertise and understanding of social and economic conditions of the recipient countries in the region.*

**3. To take into account different national circumstance and regulations:** *Countries will pursue related policies and regulatory frameworks in accordance with their respective national laws.*

I would highly appreciate it if the above elements could be reflected in the draft outcome document for further deliberations by Member States during future drafting sessions.
