

BIOGRAPHY OF CALEB MAILONI FUNDANGA

Dr Caleb Mailoni Fundanga has served as Governor of the Bank of Zambia since March of 2002. He was appointed Governor, after serving as Senior Advisor to the President of the African Development Bank in Abidjan, Cote D'Ivoire from 1998. Dr. Fundanga further served as an Executive Director at the African Development Bank. Dr. Fundanga also served as Permanent Secretary in the Ministry of Finance for six years at Cabinet Office before finally winding up in the Office of the President as Permanent Secretary in charge of the National Commission for Development Planning. Some of his achievements include the Banker Magazine Award of "Central Banker of the Year – Global and Africa" at the beginning of 2007, as well as the Emerging Markets Magazine Award of "Central Banker of the Year 2007", bestowed in September, 2007 in Washington DC. He was also awarded the "Central banker of the Year 2008" by the Annual meetings Daily Magazine. Dr. Fundanga is currently Alternate Governor of the IMF Board of Governors. Further, he is a Member of the African Export and Import Bank Board and Executive Committee. He also serves as Board member and Vice Chairman of the Zambia Revenue Authority. He is currently the Chairman of the Junior Achievement Zambia Board and is also served as Chairperson of the Programmes Committee of the African Research Consortium.
