# Comments made by the High Commissionership for Water, Forest and Combating Desertification (Morocco) on the initial proposal of the 2017-2030 Strategic Plan of the International Arrangement on Forests

# C. Opportunities for enhanced action

It's seems important to add in this part of the Strategic Plan the following target:

**15.3**: By 2030, combat desertification, restore degraded land and soil, including land affected by desertification, drought and floods, and strive to achieve a land degradation-neutral world.

# II. IAF vision and mission statements- Options

<u>Proposal for vision Statement</u>: A world where forests are protected sustainably managed and **restored**, providing economic, social and environmental benefits for all.

<u>Proposal for Mission Statement</u>: Promote implementation of SFM and enhance the contribution of forests and forest goods and services to the 2030 Agenda by strengthening cooperation, coordination and political commitment at all levels.

# C. Means and Resources for Implementation of the Strategic Plan

Since the GFFFN is called to play a key role for securing needed funds to the implementation of the Strategic Plan, and giving that GFFFN have been established just in 2015, a kind of road map for the functioning of the GFFFN is highly required.

Recently, the Committee of Forest (FAO) during its 23th session, held in July 2016, has recommended to FAO to help Countries in setting up a financing strategy for forest sector. In this regards, some coherence could be developed with FAO (as a chair of CPF).

### V. Review Framework

This aspect should be reinforced by **establishing a set of achievement and impacts indicators** (defining data collection methods, frequency, integrate the monitoring and review process into **an information system**).

It will be also beneficial if the indicators set up could serve in **assessing the global SDG indicators related to forests.** 

# VI. Communication and outreach strategy

The interest is higher to promote the coordination with the secretariats of the CBD, UNFCCC and UNCCD to improve and harmonize communication of information on forests.
