# **UNFF Expert Group Meeting on**

# The Quadrennial Programme of Work 2021-2024

#### Conference Room VIII- Palais des Nations

#### 14-15 November 2019, Geneva-Switzerland

#### **Concept Note**

## I. Background

In accordance with the Quadrennial Programme of Work of the United Nations Forum on Forests (UNFF) for the period 2017-2020<sup>1</sup>, the fifteenth session of the UNFF (UNFF15), to be held on 4-8 May 2020 at UNHQ in New York is expected to adopt the Quadrennial Programme of Work (4POW) of the UNFF for the period 2021-2024, including consideration of its priority actions and resource needs.

The UNFF14 Chair's summary also contains an indicative list of intersessional activities to be undertaken by the Secretariat in preparation for UNFF15, including elaboration of draft elements for the 4POW 2021-2024 in consultation with Members of the Forum, taking into account the post-2020 cycle of the High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF)<sup>2</sup>.

To facilitate an informed decision by UNFF15, the Secretariat circulated a brief questionnaire (contained in Annex I of this Concept Note) on 19 August 2019 to Members of the Forum to gather their initial ideas and suggestions on the 4POW 2021-2024<sup>3</sup>. The Secretariat will organize this expert group meeting on 14-15 November in Geneva to consider the results of the survey and, elaborate possible elements for the next 4POW, with the view to making a proposal on the 4POW 2021-2024. In advance of the expert meeting, the Secretariat will circulate a concise discussion paper which contains the review of survey results and possible elements for the 4POW 2021-2024 for consideration by the expert meeting.

#### II. Objective

The expert group meeting provides an opportunity for Members of the Forum, as well as partners, to review and discuss the results of the survey and elaborate possible elements for the next 4POW, with a view to making a proposal on the 4POW 2021-2024, taking into account lessons learned from the implementation of the 4POW 2017-2020 as set out in Annex II of ECOSOC resolution 2017/4 (paragraphs 1-6 and tables 1-4)<sup>4</sup>. Based on its review, the expert meeting is expected to make a proposal on the 4POW 2021-2024 for consideration by UNFF15.

The outcome of the expert group meeting will be a concise summary of the discussion, including a proposal on the 4POW 2021-2024. A brief overview of the discussion and outcome of the expert meeting will be incorporated in the relevant official document for consideration by UNFF15.

The expert meeting will bring together experts from Member States, member organizations of the Collaborative Partnership on Forests, regional and subregional organizations and processes, as well as major groups and other relevant stakeholders.
