Göran Therborn is the Chair of Sociology at Cambridge University, UK, and is the Co-Director (on leave) of the Swedish Collegium for Advanced Study in the Social Sciences (SCASSS) in Uppsala. He has done some short-term expert consulting for the UN, on social integration and on family relations. His latest books are, Inequalities of the World (London, Verso, 2006), Asia and Europe in Globalization (co-ed. with H. Khondker, Leiden, Brill, 2006), Between Sex and Power: Family in the World, 1900-2000 (London, Routledge, 2004). While still working on those themes, he is currently pursuing a research project on capital cities of the world.
