
Proportion of women aged 20-24 years who were married or in a union before age 18 (%)

▲ Marriage before the age of 18 is a fundamental violation of Human Rights. Worldwide, an estimated **640million** girls and women alive today were married in childhood, or 12 million girls per year.



Bangladesh is home to **38 million** child brides, of which **13 million** married before age 15



Child brides are somewhat more likely to reside in **rural areas** and to live in **poorer** households.



Married girls are over **4 times** more likely to be **out of school t**han unmarried girls.



Nearly **50%** child brides gave birth before age 18, and **80%** gave birth before age 20

▲ South Asia continues to drive global reductions and is on pace to eliminate child marriage in about 55 years. However, the region remains home to nearly a half of the world's child brides, accounts for 29% of women aged 20-24 years were married or in a union before age 18.
