UNAT held that UNDT had correctly found that the application was not receivable. UNAT dismissed the appeal and affirmed the UNDT judgment.

The Applicant contested the decision of the Ethics Office that considered that the events he had reported did not demonstrate any professional misconduct for the purposes of ST/SGB/2005/21. UNDT found that the application was not receivable ratione temporis since the Applicant had failed to submit his request for administrative review within the two-month time limit.
