# 2013-UNAT-299, Gehr

#### **UNAT Held or UNDT Pronouncements**

UNAT held that there was no merit in the appeal as UNDT correctly concluded that applications to UNDT were only receivable if the applicant had previously submitted the contested administrative decision for management evaluation and that management evaluation was a mandatory first step. UNAT dismissed the appeal and affirmed the UNDT judgment.

#### Decision Contested or Judgment/Order Appealed

The Applicant contested the alleged decision not to allow a rebuttal process to be carried out in accordance with the applicable norms. UNDT rejected the application as not receivable, as the impugned decision had not been submitted for management evaluation.

## Legal Principle(s)

Requesting management evaluation is a mandatory first step in the appeals process.
