The application is not receivable ratione temporis as time-barred.

# Decision Contested or Judgment/Order Appealed

The Applicant, a former staff member filed an application with the Dispute Tribunal contesting the decision to deny his request for an extension of the deadline for claiming his dependent repatriation benefits.

# Legal Principle(s)

Time limits for formal contestations are to be strictly enforced. The Appeals Tribunal has held that a day late is by no means de minimis (Rüger, 2016-UNAT-693). The Dispute Tribunal has no discretion to waive the applicable deadlines in this case.
