

# **UNDT/2022/136, Kamal**

## UNAT Held or UNDT Pronouncements

The application is not receivable *ratione temporis* as time-barred.

## Decision Contested or Judgment/Order Appealed

The Applicant, a former staff member filed an application with the Dispute Tribunal contesting the decision to deny his request for an extension of the deadline for claiming his dependent repatriation benefits.

## Legal Principle(s)

Time limits for formal contestations are to be strictly enforced. The Appeals Tribunal has held that a day late is by no means *de minimis* (Rüger, 2016-UNAT-693). The Dispute Tribunal has no discretion to waive the applicable deadlines in this case.

## Outcome

Dismissed as not receivable
