UNAT Held or UNDT Pronouncements

The Tribunal found that the application was not receivable in respect to the five contested decisions in the Applicant's application. The Tribunal found that, *inter alia*, the Applicant failed either to request management evaluation of a contested decision or because the Applicant's management evaluation was time barred. With respect to contested decision 5, the Tribunal found that the application was not receivable *ratione materiae* because the Applicant had failed to clearly identify a reviewable administrative decision.

Decision Contested or Judgment/OrderAppealed

The Applicant, a former staff member with the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali ("MINUSMA"), filed an application regarding the post-separation entitlements paid to him.

Legal Principle(s)

Under the consistent jurisprudence of the Appeals Tribunal, the Applicant must "identify an administrative decision capable of being reviewed" (*Haydar* 2018-UNAT-821).

Outcome

Dismissed as not receivable
