UNAT Held or UNDT Pronouncements

The Tribunal noted that under staff rule 11.2(a), requesting a management evaluation was indeed required, but the Applicant had not previously submitted the contested administrative decision for management evaluation. Accordingly, the Tribunal found that the application was not receivable.

Decision Contested or Judgment/Order Appealed

The Applicant contested the decision not to grant him a continuing appointment.

Legal Principle(s)

Pursuant to art. 8.1(c) of the Statute of the Dispute Tribunal, “[a]n application shall be receivable if... [a]n applicant has previously submitted the contested administrative decision for management evaluation, where required”.

Outcome

Dismissed as not receivable
