Hungary aligns itself with the statement of the European Union, however, wishes to express its position in its **national capacity** regarding the **Doha Programme of Action for Least Developed Countries.**

Hungary has supported the adoption of the Doha Programme of Action, as it contains several important topics, priorities and goals for the LDCs, such as structural transformation, capacity eradication, poverty building and digitalization. Furthermore, the Doha Programme of Action is a new generation of renewed and strengthened commitments by the LDCs and their development partners grounded in the overarching goals of achieving rapid, sustainable and inclusive recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic, building resilience against future shocks, enabling graduation from the Least Developed Country category, facilitating access to sustainable and innovative financing, addressing inequalities, leveraging the power of science, technology and innovation and achieving the Sustainable Development Goals, through a reinvigorated global partnership for sustainable development.

In spite of the importance of this document, **Hungary is not in the position to support the migration-related paragraphs,** in particular **paragraph 74, 75, 77 and the relevant targets,** as it was mentioned in details in the Hungarian explanation of position made at the last meeting of the Preparatory Committee. Therefore, Hungary **dissociates** itself from the mentioned paragraphs.
