- Six months ago, at the LDC5 Conference in Qatar, Canada affirmed our commitment to work in partnership with the Least Developed Countries to advance the **Doha Programme of Action**.
- Since then, many countries have gathered in Paris at the Summit for a New Global Financing Pact.
- And in Nairobi, for the Africa Climate Summit.
- At each of these events, we have heard from LDCs about the need to evolve our partnerships, and work together on global challenges.

- About the need to invest more in locally-led development.
- And about the need for concrete reforms to the international financial architecture, to meet the needs of developing countries.

- And I believe that the work we do today, in partnership with the Least Developed Countries, cuts to the very heart of the Sustainable Development Goals – to those common threads of dignity and compassion that underpin it all.
- That is why Canada invests more than half of our bilateral international assistance in LDCs.
- For example, Canada contributes to the Least
 Developed Countries Fund, which helps the world's most vulnerable countries adapt to the effects of climate change.

- And through our partnership with the World Bank, we support the empowerment of adolescent girls in West and Central Africa...
- By addressing norms and attitudes that contribute to gender inequalities...
- And by working on issues like sexual and reproductive health and rights...
- And child, early and forced marriage.

- We know that these investments are a powerful tool to help the people who are furthest behind lift themselves out of poverty.
- People for whom the right opportunity can truly transform a life, a family, a community – and, in time, a country.
- We look forward to continuing to work together to make the Doha Programme of Action a reality.
