more than thirty years of experience in national and international civil service. Prior to her appointment as Under Secretary-General, she was the Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Bangladesh to the United Nations in New York.





Ms. Rebeca Grynspan Secretary-General of UNCTAD


Ms. Rebeca Grynspan of Costa Rica is the eighth Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD), and the first woman to lead the organization in its history. Prior to her appointment, she was the Secretary-General of the Ibero-American Conference, Under-Secretary-General of the United Nations and Associate Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme, as well as Regional Director for Latin America and the Caribbean.

First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Economy and Development of Mongolia






Hon. Manqoba Bheki Khumalo Minister of Commerce, Industry and Trade of Eswatini
