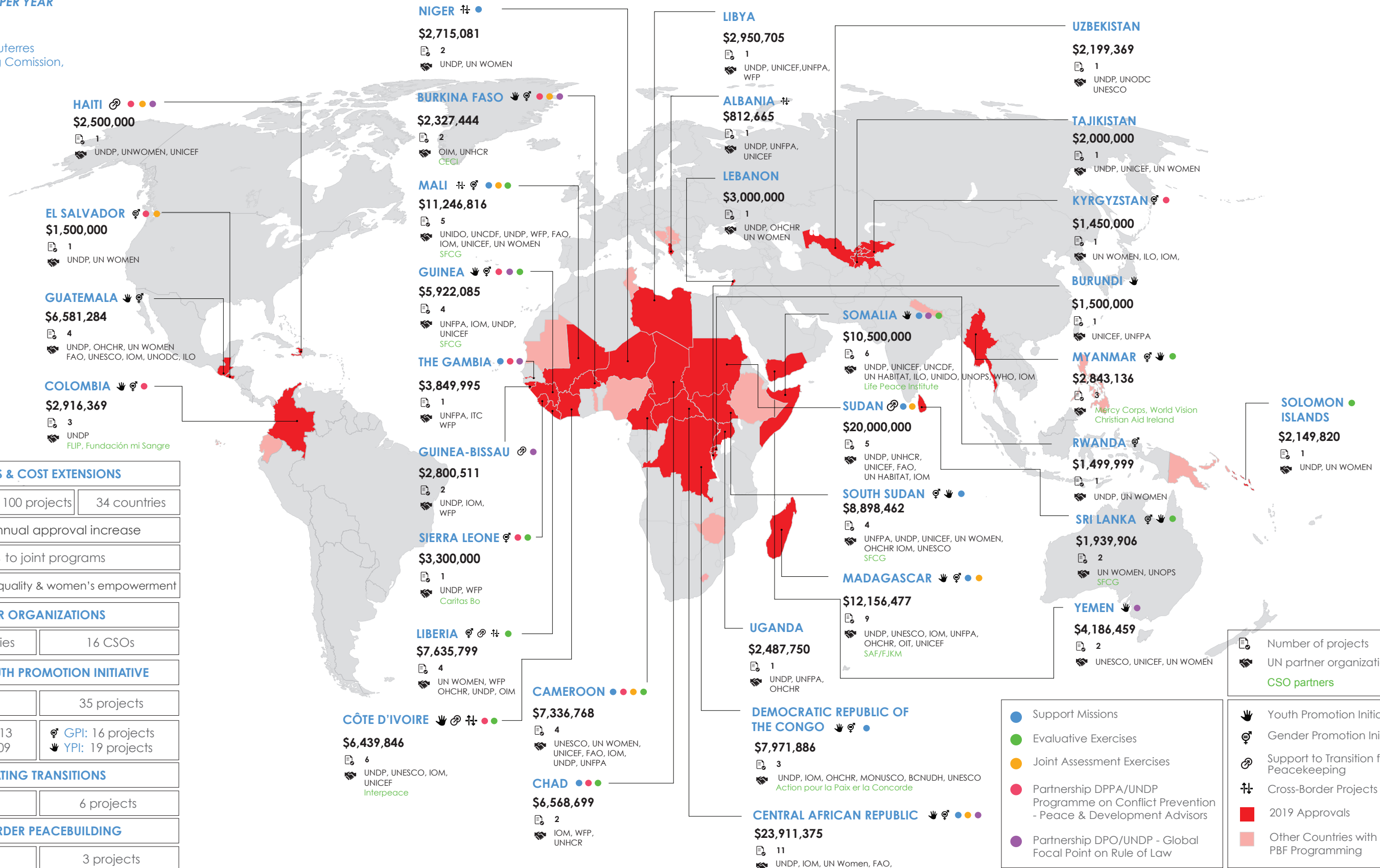


SG'S PEACEBUILDING FUND 2019

ADDRESSING CRITICAL GAPS FOR SUSTAINING PEACE

"CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE PBF HAVE INCREASED MODESTLY, BUT DEMANDS FOR SUPPORT HAVE GROWN EXPONENTIALLY AND REQUESTS FOR INVESTMENTS IN CRITICAL SITUATIONS ARE TOO OFTEN LEFT UNANSWERED. THE CURRENT SYSTEM HAS SHOWN ITS LIMITATIONS, AND SO I WANT TO REITERATE MY PLEA TO ALL MEMBER STATES FOR A "QUANTUM LEAP" OF SUPPORT TOWARDS THE \$500 MILLION PER YEAR OBJECTIVE."
