- HE Siyabonga Cwele, Minister of Telecommunications and Postal Services, South Africa

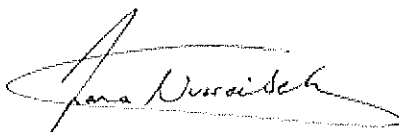
