
The letter also includes the dates and venues for the sessions on the intergovernmental negotiations for the Global Compact.

We write to you in our capacity as co-facilitators to lead the intergovernmental consultations and negotiations on issues related to the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration, the intergovernmental conference, as well as their preparatory process.

In accordance with paragraph 27 of General Assembly resolution 71/280, we are pleased to invite you to attend the presentation of the zero draft of the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration on Monday, 5 February 2018. The presentation will be held from 15:00 – 18:00 in the Trusteeship Council Chamber. The zero draft will be shared with delegations shortly before the presentation. The presentation will be open to Member States and interested stakeholders.

This informal meeting will serve to introduce the zero draft and provide delegations with information on the proceedings of the six forthcoming intergovernmental negotiation sessions between February and July 2018. While the meeting on 5 February is not intended for substantive comments on the zero draft, it will provide delegations with the opportunity for questions and comments regarding the negotiations phase of the process.
