We have the honour to write to you in our capacity as co-facilitators to lead the inter-governmental consultations on a draft Resolution to be adopted by the General Assembly for the High-level Meeting on Peacebuilding and Sustaining Peace on 24-25 April 2018.

Pursuant to the letter of the President of the General Assembly dated 13 March 2018, our aim is to facilitate the process of consultations on a draft Resolution that is concise and procedural in nature. We also subscribe to the commitment expressed by the President of the General Assembly that the process is inclusive, transparent and Member States-driven.

For ease of planning, we wish to inform you that subsequent consultations are scheduled to be held on Thursday, 29 March from 10 am to 1 pm at the Economic and Social Council Chamber and on Monday, 9 April 2018 from 3 pm to 6 pm in Conference Room 2.

We remain at your disposal to provide any clarification on the process.
