Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.



Excellency,

We have the honor in our capacities, respectively, as Chair of the Arab Group and Chair of the Summit of the Organization of the Islamic Cooperation (OIC), and in follow-up to the Arab Ministerial decision of 17 May 2018 and the OIC Summit decision of 18 May 2018, and in light of the use of veto on 1 June 2018 by a permanent member in the Security Council on a draft resolution regarding the protection of Palestinian civilian population in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem, to request the urgent resumption of the tenth emergency special session of the General Assembly in accordance with the “Uniting for Peace” procedure, as per General Assembly resolution 377(V) of 1950.

We would be grateful for your consideration of this request and for the facilitation of the convening of the General Assembly to address this serious matter as soon as possible.

We should be grateful if you would arrange to have the text of the present letter distributed as a document of the tenth emergency special session of the General Assembly, under agenda item 5.
